ENCOURAGEMENT



Beloved Church Family:

We send you this special Summer Greetings in the precious Name of Jesus and we hope our transformation as a Church would be towards greater teamwork. Teamwork is the concept of the coming together of individuals to work together to achieve a common or united purpose. For Mt Traveler this means coming together to fulfill our purpose of becoming faithful in obeying the word of God and fruitful in serving Him. Mt Traveler is continuing to focus on teamwork as our Careshare newsletters for this year will cover the first four letters of teamwork (T.E.A.M).

Summer is always one of those busiest times of the year with gardening, graduations, vacations, weddings, and family re-unions to attend. And when any team member feels encouraged, they give more efforts towards increasing the efficiency of the whole team for success. In fact, encouragement is a gift and an ability to cheer others up to rise up beyond their present condition, circumstances or situation. Therefore, any time a team observes that a member is its "weakest link", it rallies around such a member for support such that other teams will not be able to exploit that weakness. And as a team, Mt Traveler Church members must learn to support those that are weak among us otherwise they will be discouraged and give up making any efforts thus jeopardizing the success of our whole team in ministry.

A FEW SERIOUS MESSIANIC COMMUNITY BEHAVIORS TO OBSERVE DURING VISITATION

When visiting the sick, go with a humble spirit and a pleasant attitude. Do not go on a day when you do not feel well. Your purpose is to encourage the sick person, so be at your best before you visit. Do not bring up unpleasant subjects during discussions and keep your visit short. Share a scripture and prayer but do not disturb other patients in the hospital room. In the home of a sick person, determine opportunities to be of service but do not invade privacy when and where help is not wanted.

In Nursing Homes, it is possible to meet many needs but you must first obtain permission and have a clear understanding with the staff of the institution before doing anything or bringing in items, even if you are a family member. The wishes of the patient are to be considered first if there is no life threatening condition. Christian principle demands that we treat others as we wish to be treated.

When visiting the bereaved, it is not necessary to force a conversation. The hurt of losing a loved one often causes loss of words. Take the opportunity just to "be there". You may want to take along some light reading matter. Do not "probe" into "how it happened" but just listen attentively when the bereaved offers information.

In homes there may be chores that need to be done. Give help when and wherever you can but do not insist when the patient ask you not to. Refrain from discussing untidy conditions that you might have observed in a home. If it is possible to get the situation remedied please do so without embarrassing anyone. Show love and concern at all costs.


